

Table 4a. The Revells of Derbyshire (Revised June 1st 2011)

Revell of Ogston listed among the Derbyshire yeomanry in 1433

John Revell of Shirland Castle extant 1443 and thought to have been born not later than ca 1423. For descendants see Table 4d

Thomas Revell, Serjeant-at-Law, of Higham born in the period 1400 to 1430 married Alice Dowham. Possibly second son

Another brother?

Need to account for Edward Revell who dispossessed his 'cousin' Dame Alice Babbington of Carnfield Hall in 1502. Some evidence to suggest that this might be Hugh Revell who married Margery Greenalgh

John Revell, possibly born before 1450, married Margaret North. Founder of the Ogston branch. John died intestate before 1489. Margaret married Richard Page. Children John and Agnes Revell mentioned in will of brother Hugh

Robert Revell will dated May 12th 1490. Said to have died childless but probably father of Elizabeth and Grace? Named in brother Hugh's will

Hugh Revell married Margery Greenalgh. Hugh died 1504. Founder of the Carnfield branch

Richard Revell married Maria de Lee. Richard was knighted by Richard III at Bosworth in 1485. Subsequently attainted and later changed his allegiance

It is suggested that the first son, name unknown, died without issue but the evidence for this is obscure

John Revell (possibly born as early as 1465) married Margery / Margaret Eyre who predeceased him (1500?). John married second Isabel Willoughby nee Bradburne (will dated July 28th 1550). John's will dated October 27th 1537. He died November 16th 1537 and was buried Shirland in an ornate tomb.

Agnes Revell named in will of Uncle Hugh dated 1504

Grace Revell named in will of Uncle Hugh dated 1504

Elizabeth Revell niece of Hugh married in 1498 the grandson of William and Alice Wolhouse of Glapwell

Three sons and two daughters. See Table 4c

Thomas Revell said to have been born about 1496. The will (1559) of Thomas Revell of Shirland probably relates to this individual. Refers to wife Elizabeth?, eldest son Robert, a Maria? Revell of Wolley and John Wolley of Riber. Held land at Temple Normanton ca 1507 to 1518? Is he Thomas Revell, gent., who witnessed deeds at Buxton in 1509, and Thomas of Tyrydswoold (Tideswell), father of Humphrey? See also Thomas son of Tristram Table 4c

Note that because of space constraints children are not necessarily arranged in their order of birth, and in some branches some generations occupy TWO rows

Individuals shown thus are those for whom no descendants are identified and who might thus be the head of otherwise unconnected branches

Three daughters inferred from carvings on their father's tomb, but dead by 1537

Hugh Revell of Higham shown tentatively in Gladwyn Turbutt's 'A History of Ogston'. Dead before 1537? Apparently had a daughter Jane who married Thomas Shakerley of Little Longstone? This Hugh Revell might be a Hugh son of Thomas of Higham and his illegitimate daughter Joan Tanstley, see Table 5c

Edward Revell shown in Gladwyn Turbutt's 'A History of Ogston'. Extant 1537

Robert Revell born 1502? at Mansfield married Eleanor Frecheville of Staveley. Named in 'cousin' Rowland's will 1529 and named executor in father's will 1537. Robert died April 19th 1555. It is not clear whether his mother is Margaret or Isabel. Robert's widow Eleanor married Jeffrey Wastness

Leonard Revell named executor in father's will dated 1537 and holding property at Nottingham (Newstead near Mansfield?) with his (step-)mother Isabel. Leonard presumably born no later than ca 1517

Dorothy Revell married Richard Selyock. It is not clear whether her mother is Margaret or Isabel

Elizabeth Revell married Edward Meryng described as an 'unkind son-in-law' in his father-in-law's will. Named in brother Robert's will dated 1555. It is not clear whether her mother is Margaret or Isabel

Humphrey Revell, probably born ca 1520 to 1530. Alebrower of London, apprenticed to Richard Pyckeryng and registered as a Freeman in 1546. Married firstly May 9th 1552 at St Michael's, Crooked Alley, Alles Harrington (buried February 18th 1563 / 4) and married secondly Elizabeth Browne on April 10th 1564

Maria (Mary) Revell who married John Woolley of Riber / Allen Hill, Matlock before 1559. John Woolley buried Matlock June 8th 1585

Robert Revell of Shirland, eldest son named in father's will 1559. Thought to have married Agnes Eliyot of Thorpe-by-Ashborne August 4th 1555. Will dated 1585 / 6 refers to wife Agnes and children Robert, Rycharde, Sythe, Marie Elizabeth and Margaret

Other children implied but not named in father's will. Do they include Thomas Revell of Beighton who died 1590 / 1 and Heughe Revell of Carlton-in-Lindrick (Nottinghamshire) born no later than ca 1563?

Hellen Revell ?

Other children implied but not named in father's will. Possibly including John, grandson of Richard Revell

Eldest son John Revell born no later than ca 1525 married Margaret / Mary Comberford who was born after 1528. He is named in his grandfather's will (1537) and father's will 1555 (lead smelting, farms in Shirland and Stretton). John's will dated 1568, died 1572 / 3. Probate granted 1576 / 7. Refers to (half-)brother John in will

Third son Leonard Revell named in grandfather John Revell's will dated 1537 and father Robert Revell's will dated 1555 and inherits land at Birchwood (Alfreton), Shirland Park, and Stretton. Possibly the Leonard Revell of Shirland who died 1561 but will since lost. Possibly husband of Elizabeth see Table 5b

Tristram Revell not named in grandfather John Revell's will dated 1537 or father's will dated 1555 and dead by then if not before

Symon Revell named in brother John's will 1568 but not in his putative father's will dated 1555 or putative grandfather's will dated 1537

Ann Revell named in father's will dated 1555 when younger than 18

Daughter Eleanor Revell (widow of Nicholas) in father's will dated 1555 so born no later than ca 1535. Possibly married second Parsons and dead by 1563

Grace Revell named in father's will dated 1555 when younger than 18. According to Gladwyn Turbutt married Thomas Barlow of Dronfield Woodhouse

Marcel Revell named in father's will dated 1555 as having house and lands in Brampton

Margery Revell named in father's will 1555

Leonard Revell of Shirland died 1603. Will names cousin Robert Revell of Shirland and brother Robert Revell of Beighton. No wife or children named but possibly married Elizabeth Hatfield at Mansfield on July 29th 1571

Robert Revell of Beighton died 1627, brother of Robert Revell of Shirland. Will names wife Maria but no children

Heughe Revell of Carlton-in-Lindrick (born no later than ca 1563) who married Betteris Johnson July 14th 1583

Elder son John Revell born 1553 (needs confirmation) married Margaret Harris nee Beighton in the period 1577 to 1581. John was buried Morton on December 27th 1592 and Margaret married Robert Collyor. Margaret's sister married George Torre

Second son Edward Revell named in father's will 1568. Inherited lands in North Wingfield and Chesterfield. Thought to be an Alumnus of Gloucester Hall, Oxford, who matriculated on January 11th 1581 / 2 aged 19

Ellinor Revell named in father's will (1568) and inherited property in Newark-upon-Trent (Nottinghamshire). Married Edward Fenton of Fenton, Nottinghamshire. Held one third of Saracen's Head, Newark 1582 / 3. Campaigned against her brother and extant 1591

Joan (Jane) Revell named in father's will (1568) inherited property in Eggestone and Tupton, North Wingfield

A mysterious John recorded as 'my youngest sonne' in his father's will dated 1555 and as 'brother of John' in eldest son John's will dated 1568, but not in the will of his putative grandfather (1537). Stanley C. Taylor describes him as extant 1550, an illegitimate son of Robert. Such information as is available indicates that he is probably John Revell of Mansfield extant 1584 to 1597. See also Table 4c and Part 6

Second son Robert (described as of 'Wynster' in his grandfather's will dated 1537) and five children named in father's will 1555 (40 marks) so born no later than ca 1525, and a beneficiary in the 1568 will of elder brother John (who married Margaret Comberford). Probably Robert married Helen Savage nee Dethick but others say her husband was a John Revell

Roberte Revell of Shirland named cousin in will (1603) of Leonard Revell of Shirland. Will dated 1613 names brother-in-law Roger Atkinson

Rycharde Revell

Sythe Revell married Robert Low at Worksop (Nottinghamshire) on January 10th 1596 / 7

Marie Revell

Elizabeth Revell married Roger Atkinson at Carlton-in-Lindrick (Nottinghamshire) on September 22nd 1594

Margaret Revell

Eldest son Edward Revell of Ogston baptised North Wingfield January 1st 1579 / 80, but said to be 15 when his father died in 1592. Edward apparently married twice, first a Jane, and second Alice Lacey. His will (Edward Renell of Ognaston) is dated 1642 and probated 1647. He died childless

Second son Robert Revell baptised at North Wingfield on February 12th 1580 / 81 married Anne Kneiler (Knowles, Knowles)

Michael Revell possibly died abroad mentioned in father's will dated 1592

John Revell died childless mentioned in father's will and brother Edward's will (1642). John's will 1656 / 7 refers to cousin Mary Torre, nephews William, Francis and Edward, and nieces Anne, Alice, Jane and Elizabeth

George Revell baptised at Morton on February 2nd 1586 / 7 and was buried at Lenton, Nottinghamshire, on June 8th 1632

Thomas Revell baptised at Morton February 24th 1591 and was buried there September 15th 1597

A Francis Revell, father John, baptised North Wingfield May 19th 1578 and buried December 21st 1578 might belong here

Bennet Reyvell named in grandfather's will dated 1555 but apparently dead by 1568 as not named in Uncle John's will

Elen Reyvell named in grandfather's will dated 1555. Named in Uncle John's will dated 1568

Mary Reyvell named in grandfather's will dated 1555. Named in Uncle John's will dated 1568

Ann Reyvell named in grandfather's will dated 1555. It is presumably this Ann Revell who was caring for her Uncle John at the time of his death (1568)

Robert Reyvell named in grandfather's will dated 1555

Edward Revell (of Chesterfield) baptised at Morton on March 18th 1618 / 9, married Frances Hooker nee Webster at Dronfield on July 2nd 1635. He was disinherited by his Uncle Edward. Named, but not to benefit, in Uncle John's will 1656 / 7. Wife recorded in John's will as Margaret, presumably second marriage to Margaret Catton

Ann Revell baptised at Morton on December 9th 1627, married a John Curtis (Curtis) at Morton on February 3rd 1658 and they emigrated to the New World probably arriving in the period 1682-1684. Mentioned in will of Uncles Edward and John

William Revell baptised at Morton on April 27th 1625, married Mary Sitwell. Mentioned in Uncle Edward's will 1642 and Uncle John's will 1656 / 7

Jane Revell is said to have married first Robert Braithwait and secondly Godfrey Swift. Mentioned in Uncle Edward's will 1642 and Uncle John's will 1656 / 7

Mary Revell baptised at Morton December 20th 1603

Edward Revell baptised at Morton March 11th 1606

Francis Revell married Anna Goose at Lenton on June 17th 1658. Mentioned in Uncle Edward's will 1642 and Uncle John's will 1656 / 7

Thomas Revell baptised at Chesterfield on August 13th 1637. In 1653 apprenticed John Pearson, cutter. Married Mary Potts and emigrated to the New World from Hull aboard the 'Shield' arriving 1678. A series of births (some at Whiston, Yorkshire) and baptisms (father Thomas) at Sheffield (Yorkshire) in the period 1662 to 1680 have been attributed to Thomas Revell and Mary Potts, but are almost certainly incorrect. See also Table 5d

Elizabeth Revell baptised at Morton on November 6th 1631, mentioned in Uncle Edward's will 1642 and Uncle John's will 1656 / 7

Dorothy Revell mentioned in Uncle Edward's will 1642

Alice Revell baptised at Morton on June 6th 1621, married Henry Strelley. Mentioned in Uncle Edward's will 1642 and Uncle John's will 1656 / 7

Thomas Revell recorded Burlington, New Jersey, in 1683 and probably born no later than ca 1661 but baptism not located. May have returned to England

Elizabeth Revell recorded Burlington, New Jersey, in 1682 and probably born no later than ca 1661 but baptism not located. Married in Burlington on February 20th 1688

Mary Revell baptised at Chesterfield on May 23rd 1670

Anne Revell baptised at Chesterfield on December 22nd 1671. Married in Burlington on April 12th 1694

A daughter baptised at Chesterfield on January 6th 1675 / 6 but name not recorded. Thought to be Hannah Revell who married in Burlington
